

**2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Mother/Daughter Golf Outing**  
**Tuesday, June 4**

**Woodland Hills Executive Nine**

This is a non-competitive golf outing for women and daughters. Woodland Hills Executive Nine is a 9-hole course of par-3 and par-4 holes. June 4 is recognized as the national Women's Golf Day – a day to unite women through golf across the globe for 24 hours.

- Light meal served at 5:00 pm, play begins at 5:30 pm.
- Scramble format, each person in a group tees off, then, as a group, decides which ball to use for the next shot. Each player then plays from this position. This format continues until the ball goes in the hole.
- A golf volunteer will walk with each group. The golf volunteers know how to golf and will help with course management such as proper etiquette and pace of play. He/she is there for support.
- To keep pace of play, if the group does not get a ball on the green in par strokes (3 or 4 strokes) then the volunteer can be used to put the ball on the green. Once a ball is on the green, then each person in the group takes turns putting from the best position.
- Even though this is a non-competitive outing, each group will keep score and the volunteer will verify scores.
